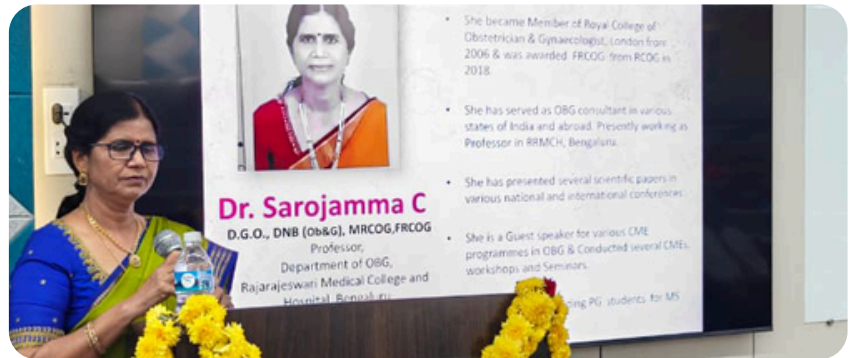
Academic & Administrative Audit (AAA) Conducted at ACU Bengaluru campus

World Immunization Week observation at UHTC

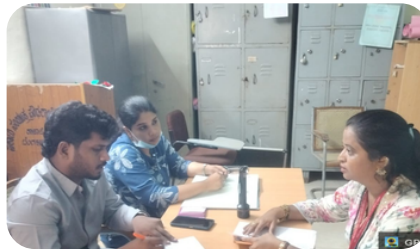

CME on AI Pharma 2026

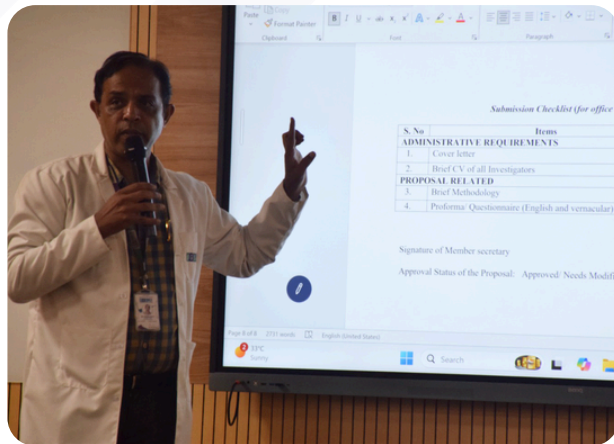

Clean Campus, Clean Conscience: Earth Day Week Report

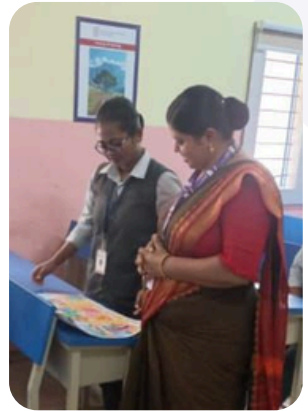

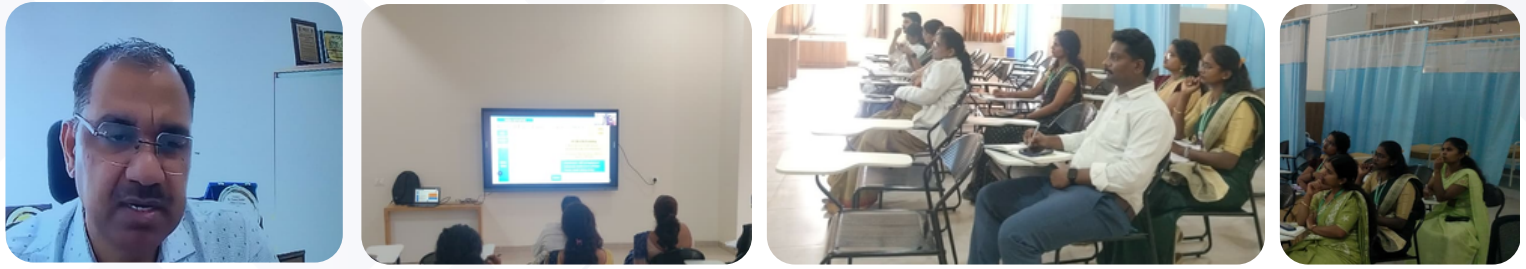

Educational Visit to Drone Technology Exhibition

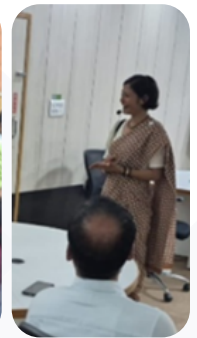

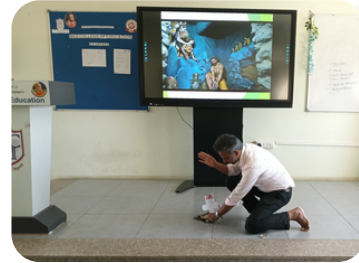


The expert interacted with faculty members and students, emphasizing the importance of critical thinking and active learning. The audit feedback is expected to further enhance institutional practices and academic excellence.
